A/AN

We use a or an when we talk about a thing or a person for the first time.

Here's **a** big book for you, Trig.

THE

We use the when we talk about the same thing or person for the second time.

The big book's an English dictionary.

Indefinitive articles

We use "a" with nouns that <u>begin</u> with a <u>consonant sound</u>. Example:

- a trumpet
- a bike
- a pencil
- a car

We use "an" with nouns that <u>begin</u> with a vowel sound. Example:

an animal.

an elephant

an orchestra

an ice cream
