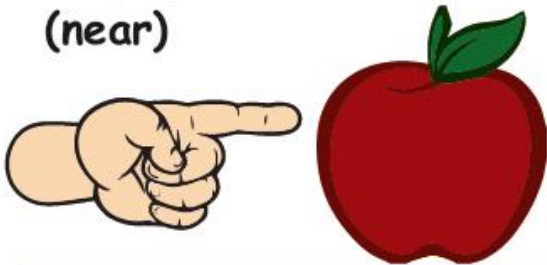


DEMONSTRATIVE PRONOUNS

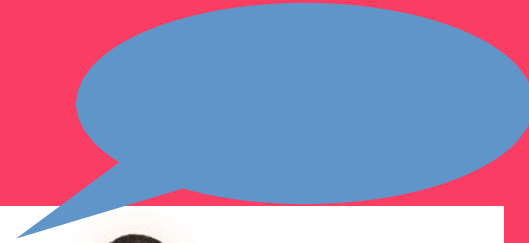
