Other time expressions

• Every -----

• *Cada----*

I listen to music every morning.

• Once a week

• *Una vez a la semana*

You play soccer once a week.

• Twice a month

• *Dos veces al mes*

He washes the car twice a month.

• Three times

• *Tres veces*

She eats three times a day.

• On the weekends

• *Los fines de semana*

It takes a shower on the weekends.

• On weekdays

• *Entre semana*

We work on weekdays.

• Before

• *Antes*

They study before an exam.

• After

• *Después*

I brush my teeth after breakfast.

Sentences

Positive +

I take a shower in the morning.

You read a book in the evening.

He cleans the house on the weekends.

She eats breakfast in the morning.

It plays with the ball at night.

We mop the floor everyday.

They watch a movie twice a week.

Negative -

I don't take a shower in the morning.

You don't read a book in the evening.

He doesn't clean the house on the weekends.

She doesn't eat breakfast in the morning.

It doesn't play with the ball at night.

We don't mop the floor everyday.

They don't watch a movie twice a week.

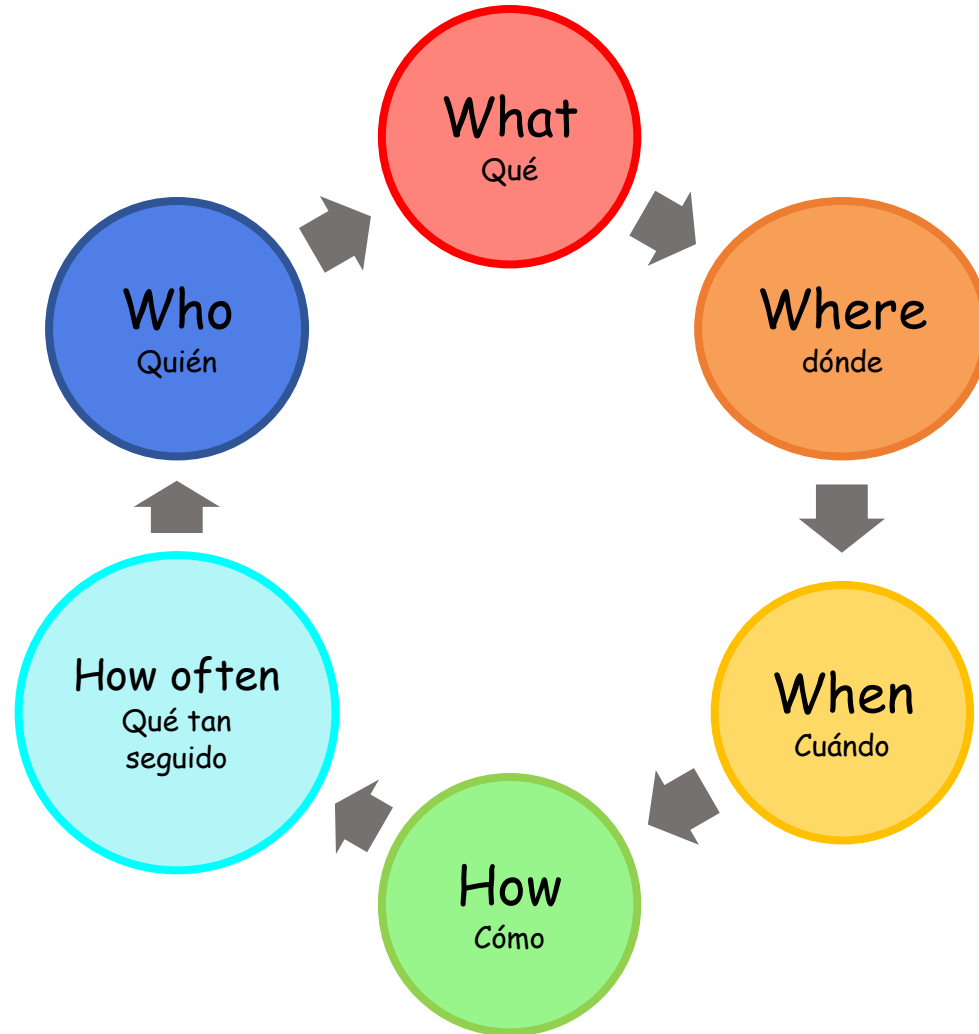
Subject + don't/doesn't
