We use possessive adjectives:

- to show **something belongs** to somebody:

*That's **our** house.*

***My** car is very old.*

- for **relations** and **friends**:

***My** mother is a doctor.*

*How old is **your** sister?*

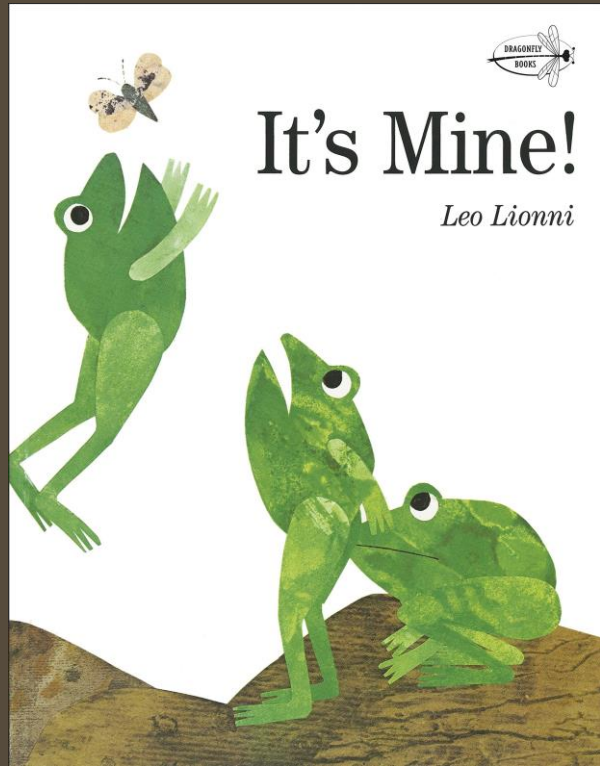
- for **parts of the body**:

*He's broken **his** arm.*

*She's washing **her** hair.*

*I need to clean **my** teeth.*

Be careful!

The possessive adjective **its** does **not** have an apostrophe ('):

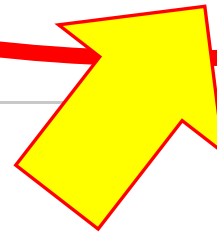
*That bird has broken **its** (NOT **it's**) wing.*

*(it's always means it is or it has.)*

**our**

**their**

# HOW TO USE THE INDEFINITE ARTICLES *A* VS. *AN*

The two indefinite articles in English are *a* and *an*. The indefinite article *an* is used to make pronunciation easier when reading a text aloud. The general rule is to use *a* when the indefinite article precedes a word beginning with a consonant sound and *an* when it precedes a word starting with a vowel sound.

Vowels

A, E, I, O, U

Consonant

B, C, D, F, G, H,  
J, K, L, M, N, P,  
Q, R, S, T, V, W,  
X, Y, Z

# ATTENTION!!

We do **NOT** use an .indefinite article with **plural nouns** or **uncount nouns**.

EG. SHE WAS WEARING BLUE SHOES

EG. SHE HAS SHORT, BLONDE HAIR
