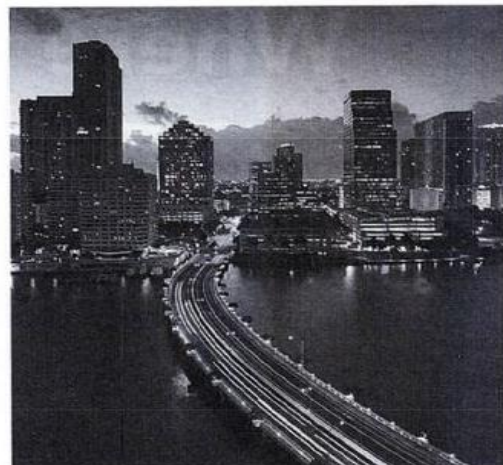

Sandra: Detroit? Really? My parents WERE born in Detroit, too!

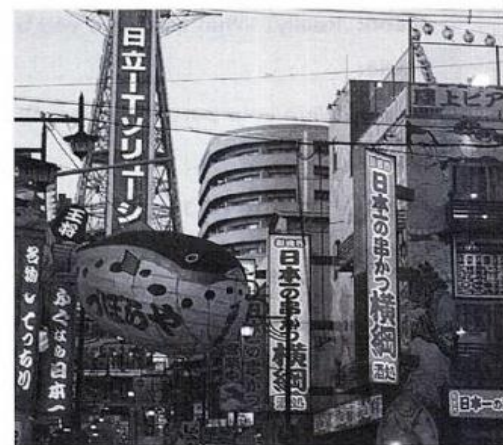
2. Kristin: I called you on Saturday, but you WEREN'T home.

 Kristin: WERE your parents there?









Jennifer: No, they WEREN'T. I WAS with my sister. It WAS great!
