Mindy: So where were you last year?

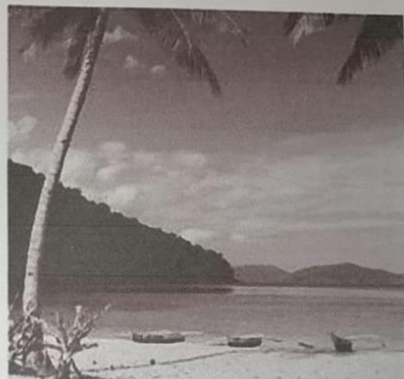
Alan: I was in Japan.

Alan: I was an English teacher.

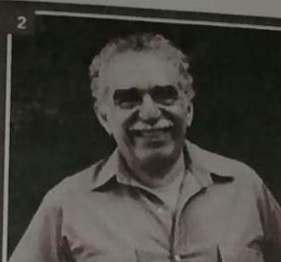

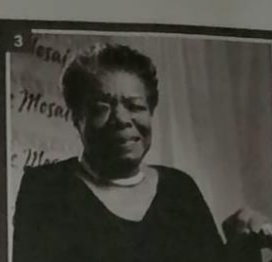
Marie Curie, scientist (1867-1934)

- wrote *I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings*, 1969



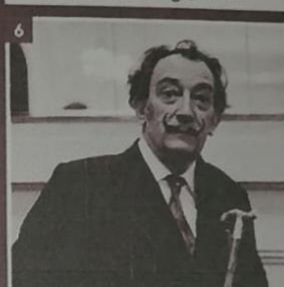
Pat Morita, actor (1932-2005)
