Mindy: So where were you last year?

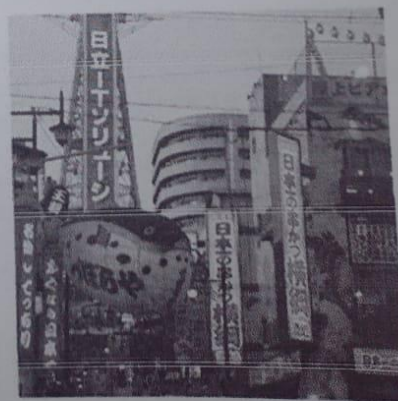
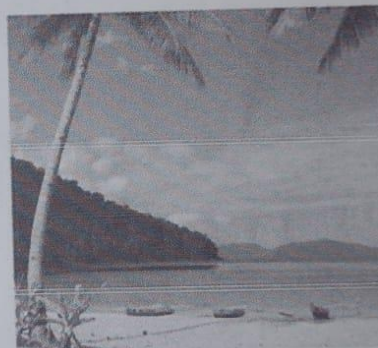
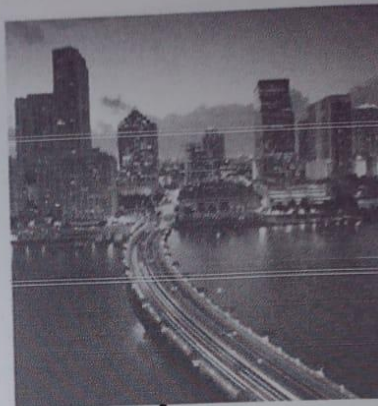
Alan: I was in Japan.

Mindy: What was the job?

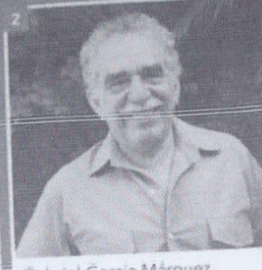

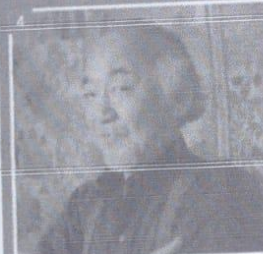
Marie Curie, scientist (1867-1934)
