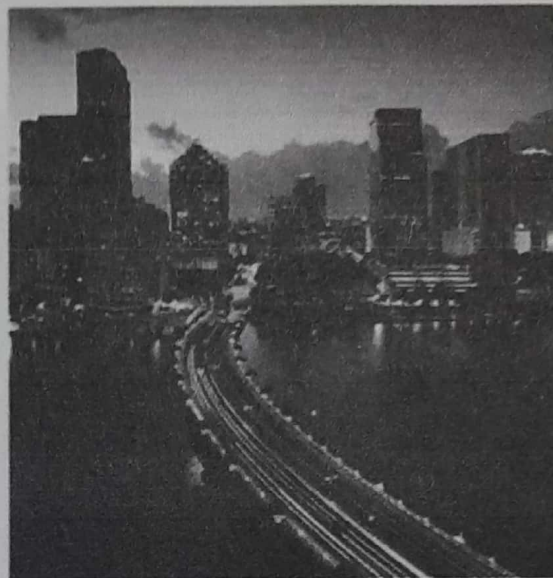

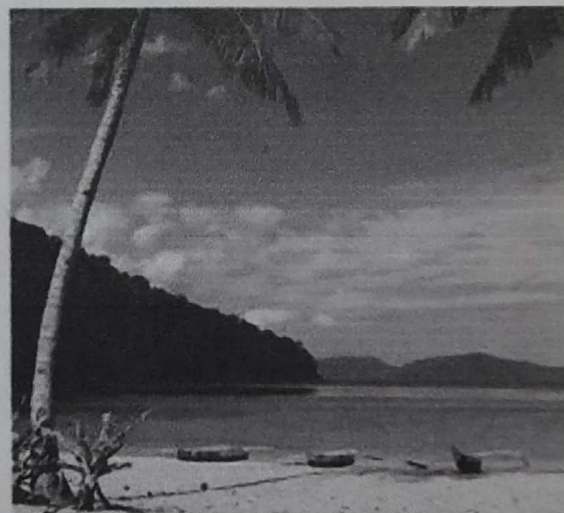

- won Nobel Prizes in 1903 and 1911



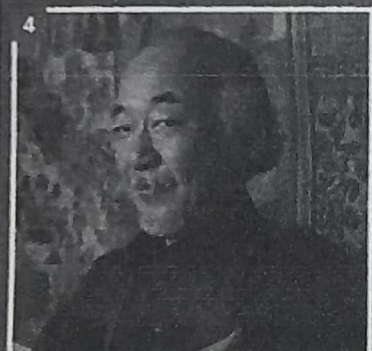
2 Gabriel Garcia Márquez, author (1927-2014)
