Hot

Warm, macrothermal or megathermic climates have high annual average temperatures, above 18 °C every month and without great seasonal variations.

Are located in the equatorial, tropical and subtropical bands of the planet,

Types of weather.

Warm

The temperature ranges between 12 and 18 ° C and the average rainfall is between 600 mm and 2,000 mm annually.

The temperate climate is between tropical climates and polar climates, so they are located mainly in the temperate zone of the Earth between latitudes 23 ° and 66 °; and therefore includes both mesothermic (C) and microthermal climates

Polar

It is an extremely cold place with temperatures that can reach -70°C. There is not much variety of vegetation other than some mosses and lichens that grow in the summer season

The Polar Zones are the areas located around the geographic North and South Poles of the earth and are characterized mainly by having temperatures almost permanently below freezing.
