- Is he going to visit her next week? Yes, he is going to visit her next week. (¿Él la va a visitar la siguiente semana? Sí, él la va a visitar la próxima semana)
- Is my brother going to visit us tomorrow? No, he is going to visit us day after tomorrow. (¿Mi hermano va a visitarnos mañana? No, él va a visitarnos pasado mañana)
- Is Jane going to start her new job next week? No, she is going to start her new job next month. (¿Jane va a comenzar su nuevo trabajo la próxima semana? No, ella va a comenzar su nuevo trabajo el siguiente mes)
- Are they going to spend the day together? No, they are going to work all day. They are going to spend the weekend together. (¿Ellos van a pasar el día juntos? No, ellos van a trabajar todo el día. Ellos van a pasar el fin de semana juntos)

Rule 4

- What are we going to do tomorrow? We are going to wash our clothes. (¿Qué vamos a hacer mañana? Vamos a lavar nuestra ropa)
- When is she going to visit her brother? She is going to visit her brother tomorrow morning. (¿Cuándo va ella a visitar a su hermano? Ella va a visitar a su hermano mañana en la mañana)
- What are you going to give your wife for her birthday? I am going to give her a bracelet. (¿Qué le vas a dar a tu esposa en su cumpleaños? Le voy a dar una pulsera)
