Sentences

Affirmative

- Rafael **can** swim very fast.
- I **can** play guitar.
- You **can** cook very well
- We **can** travel by car.
- The **can** fix cars.

Negative

- She **can't** stay up all night.
- Charlie **can't** drive very well.
- She **can't** walk.
- They **can't** hear you.
- We **can't** visit Kate today.

Interrogative

- **Can** you dance?
- **Can** the baby talk?
- **Can** your sister play piano?
- **Can't** you run faster?
- **Can't** you turn on the tv?
