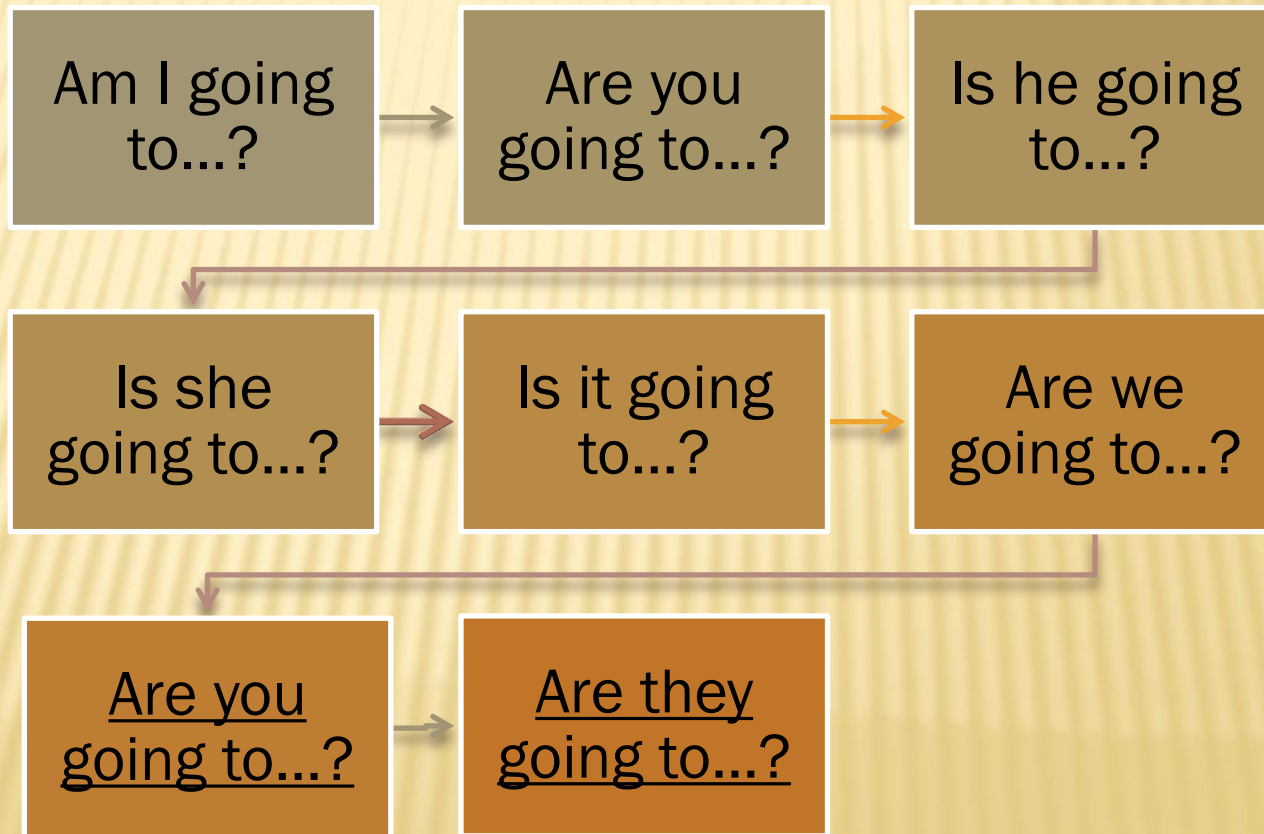

Are you going to study to be a lawyer?
No, You Aren't

Is he going to visit her next week?
Yes, He Is

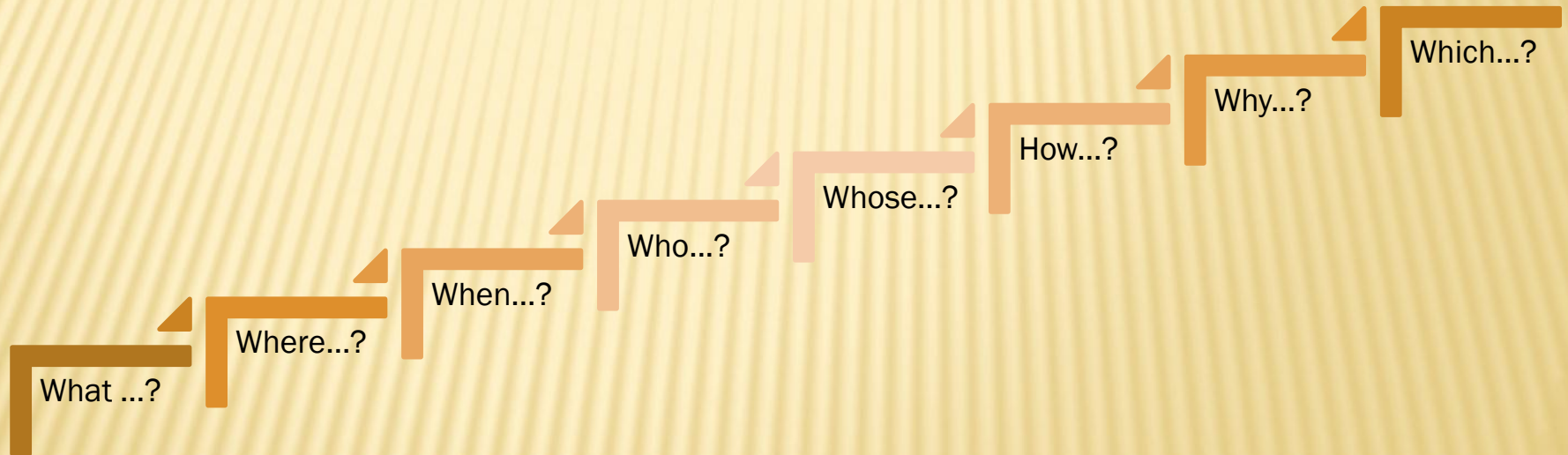
Is she going to wait me after the show?
