Negation of an obligation or advice can be expressed with **should not** or with its contraction **shouldn't**.

It has already been mentioned that **should** can be understood as a **moral obligation**, or convenience in doing something, or as the probability of doing something or of something happening.

INDICATIONS

You should not call her every day

They should not help you with your cleaning

We should not take an exam

She should not eat much

My dog shouldn't go out

You shouldn't wash your car

He shouldn't go to the dance

You shouldn't throw trash



A question about an obligation or advice can be expressed by writing **should** before the subject of the sentence.

It is usually used to ask someone or to ask for advice, so the "do you think" is used:
do you think + subject + should + verb + complement +?
Should + subject + verb + complement +?

INDICATIONS

Should she go shopin with us?

Yes, she should

Should I go to the gym more often? Yes, he should

Should they work more at night? Yes ,they should

Should You Email Your Work?
Yes, he should

Should you prepare your lunch?
Yes, I should

Should we ask permission to leave?
Yes, we should

Should you invest more in your business? Yes, he should

Should it rain tonight?
Yes, I should
