Luis: I was sixteen.

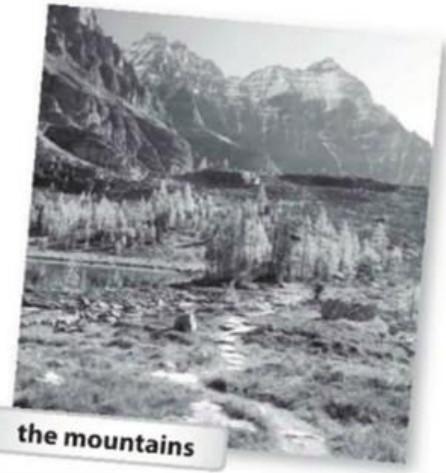

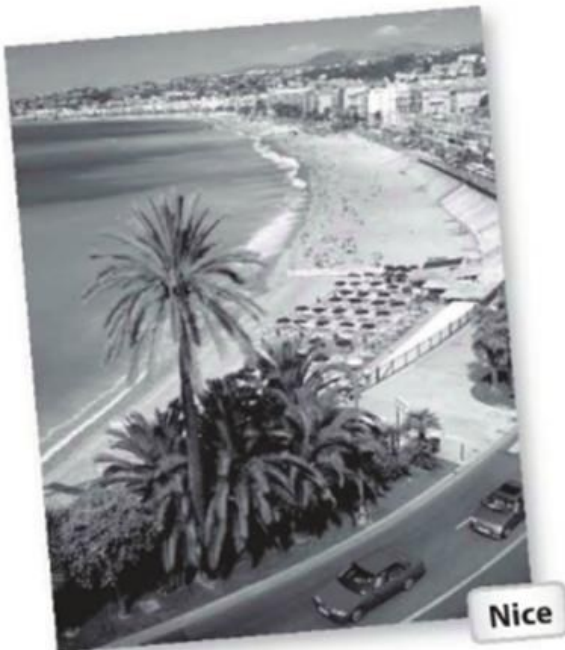

 Sue: Chicago? Really? My parents were born in Chicago, too!




1  **Frida Kahlo, painter**
