GRAMMAR

The Present Simple tense: questions with "who" as subject.

Who washes the dishes in your family? | I do. / My sister does.
We do. / My grandparents do.

Be careful!

Always use a third-person singular verb when "who" is the subject.

Don't say: Who ~~wash~~ the dishes? BUT Who washes the dishes?

Don't use "do" or "does" when "who" is the subject.

Don't say: Who ~~does wash~~ the dishes?

Exercise 4. Write 5 questions using questions with "who" in present simple (Escribir 5 oraciones usando las preguntas "who" en presente simple usando el vocabulario anterior)

Example: Who travels to Tuxtla every weekend?

1. Who washes the dishes in your family? My mom does it
2. Who cleans your house? I do it
3. Who does the laundry? My sister
4. Who takes out the garbage? My father
5. Who is going to do the shopping? My mom
