# The Present Simple tense: questions with "how often" / other time expressions.

How often do you take out the garbage? I take out the garbage every day.

How often does she go shopping? She goes shopping on Saturdays.

Other time expressions once a week twice a week three times a week

Also: once a year twice a day three times a month every weekend every Friday

#### Answers

#### GRAMMAR

The Present Simple tense: questions with "who" as subject.

Who washes the dishes in your family? I do. / My sister does. We do. / My grandparents do.

Be careful!

Always use a third-person singular verb when "who" is the subject.

Don't say: Who wash the dishes? BUT Who washes the dishes?

Don't use "do" or "does" when "who" is the subject.

Don't say: Who does wash the dishes?

**Exercise 4.** Write 5 questions using questions with "who" in present simple (Escribir 5 oraciones usando las preguntas "who" en presente simple usando el vocabulario anterior)

Example: Who travels to Tuxtla every weekend?
