Ask questions about quantity with "how many". Always use a plural noun with "how many."


Example: How many bathrooms are there? (There are two.)

Exercise 1. Write 6 questions with "where" and answer the questions using the Present Simple tense


- 1. Where are you from? I am from Chiapas.
