The following describes the medical history of a person with life insurance.

GROWTH

In this document we find the necessary information to be able to provide a good service, to the person who requests it and to close relatives. In this example we analyze a life insurance file of Mr. Tony Santos.

It is made up of three sections where we find personal and family information.

Part 1: "your personal details"

There we find personal information from close family and beneficiary, as an example. First name(s), Address, Sex at birth, among other.

Part 2: "Additional member details"

Are the details of additional members that may be included in the insurance, these are first name, surname, relationship to you, date of birth.

Part 3: "your medical history"

Past and current health and medical information is requested from each person who formed part 2, divided into two parts, open and closed questions, some questions included are:

Closed questions: questions answered with yes or no, and they are complementary to the previous part

Open questions: Examples have been admitted to a hospital, a surgical operation, or any other investigation (eg, examination, X-ray, blood test, biopsy) within the past seven years.

It is important to answer everything with true information for being a legal format lying would have consequences for example:

- Policy increase if the truth is discovered
- Rejection of renewal of the policy.
- penalty for fraud
