COMPARATIVES AND SUPERLATIVES

Comparatives:

Comparative adjectives compare one person or thing with another and enable us to say whether a person or thing has more or less

Superlatives:

Superlative adjectives describe one person or thing as having more of a quality than all other people or things in a group

They are used to differentiate between characteristics shared by objects.

RULES

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1. We apply the rule of adding "er" to comparatives and "est" to superlatives

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2. We apply the rule of adding "more" before the adjective in comparatives, and "Most" to superlatives.

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3. Bisyllabic adjectives ending in "ful" or "re". We apply the rule of adding "more" before the adjective in comparatives, and "Most" to superlatives

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4. Bisyllabic adjectives ending in "y". We change the "y" to "i" and apply the rule of adding "er" to comparatives and "est" to superlatives
