finished in vowel and consonant. We double the last consonant and we apply the rule "est".

Bisyllabic adjectives ending in "er". We apply the rule of adding "est"

Irregular adjectives. They don't follow any rules and you have to learn them from memory.

We write "more" in front of the adjective and then we also add "that" at the end.

Example

I'm more interested in music than sport.

We add "er" at the end and then we put the particle "than"

Example

Mary is older peter than

Two syllables, ending in consonant + and. We change the "y" for "i" + er

Finished in "l". The "l" + er is folded

Finished in "e" mute. Only "r" is added.

we write "most" in front of the adjective (which we do notnothing), and we also added the article "the" at the beginning
