For verbs ending in vowel + consonant, double the consonant and add -ed: shop → shopped.</li> <li>Use didn't + base form in negative statements. The form doesn't change: He didn't shop for groceries yesterday. (NOT: He didn't shopped for groceries yesterday.)</li> </ul>
