- Estructura.

(+)  $\text{S} \oplus \text{BE} \oplus \text{GOING TO} \oplus \text{Complement}$

Example: I am going to the school in January

(-)  $\text{S} \oplus \text{BE} \oplus \text{NOT} \oplus \text{GOING TO} \oplus \text{Complement}$

Example: I am not going to the school in January

(?)  $\text{BE} \oplus \text{S} \oplus \text{GOING TO} \oplus \text{Complement} \oplus ?$

Example: am I going to the school in January?
