Simple past statements: regular verbs and irregular verbs (Page 32-33) → (♠)





- ▶ Use simple past verbs to talk about the past. Regular verbs end in -ed: 1 watched TV last night. For verbs ending in -e, add -d: live \rightarrow lived. For verbs ending in vowel + consonant, double the consonant and add -ed: shop -> shopped.
- Use didn't + base form in negative statements. The form doesn't change: He didn't shop for groceries yesterday. (NOT: He didn't shopped for groceries yesterday.)
