WENT ON FOR A PERIOD OF TIME

SUBJECT + WAS / WERE + VERBO WITH - ING

TO BE CONTINUED PAST THE AUXILIARY VERB TO BE AND THE PRESENT PARTICIPLE INFINITIVE + ING OF THE VERB IS USED

The auxiliary verb to be is in the simple past but keep in mind that to be is an irregular verbo

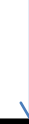
