I **was** born here.

I **wasn't** born in the U.K.
 You **weren't** very old.
 She **wasn't** in college.
 We **weren't** at the cafe.
 They **weren't** born in Peru.

wasn't = was not

weren't = were not

Yes, I **was** / No, I **wasn't**

Was your first teacher American?

Yes, she **was** / No, she **wasn't**

Were your parents born in the U.S.?

Yes, they **were** / No, they **weren't**

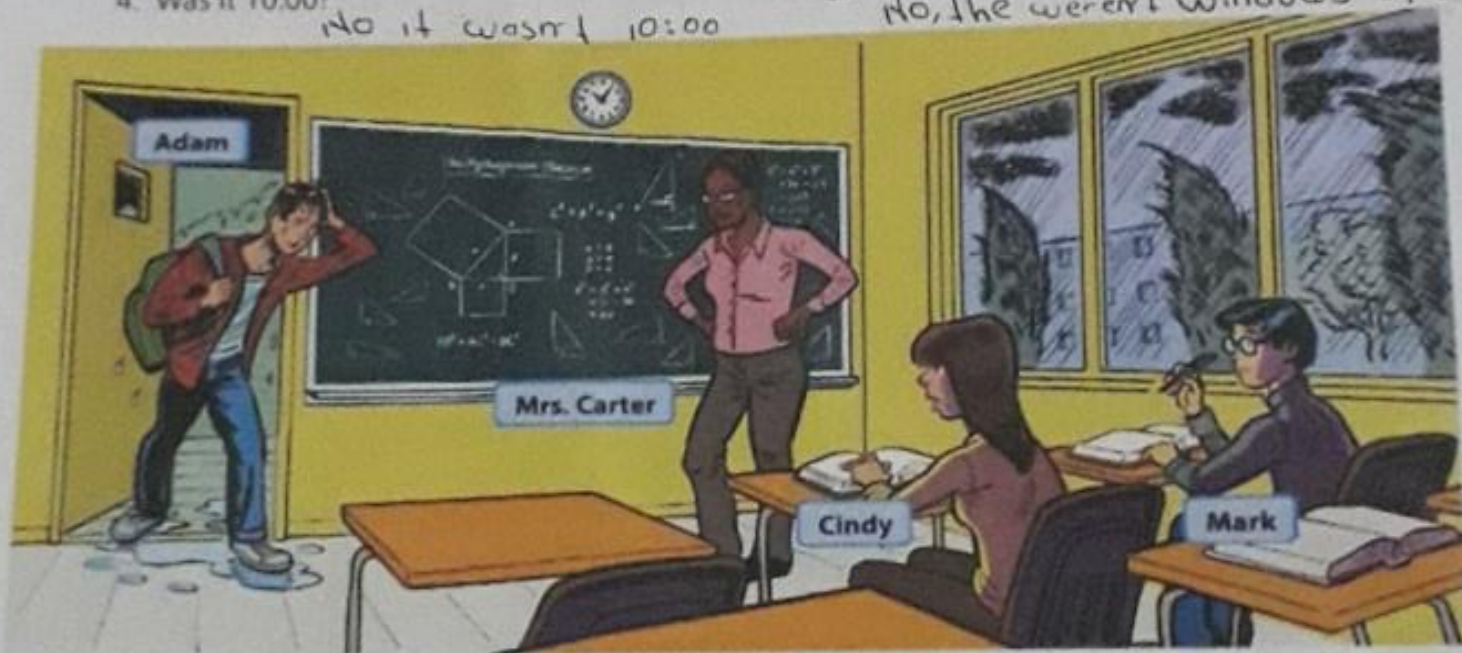
