Is she going to write a letter? - No, she is not going to write a letter

- d. Philip and Frank / have a birthday party.

Are Philip and frank going to have a birthday party? –

No, Philip and frank are not going to have a birthday party.

e. He / repair my bicycle.

Is he going to repair my bicycle? - No, he is not going to repair my bicycle

f. Your grandparents /visit you / next weekend.

Is your grandparent going to visit you next weekend? –

No, your grandparents are not going to visit next weekend.
