GRAMMAR

The Present Simple tense: questions with "who" as subject.

Who washes the dishes in your family?

I do. / My sister does. We do. / My grandparents do.

Be careful!

Always use a third-person singular verb when "who" is the subject.

Don't say: Who wash the dishes? BUT Who washes the dishes?

Don't use "do" or "does" when "who" is the subject.

Don't say: Who does wash the dishes?
