Questions for quantities, How much? and How many?

Example

How + much / many + incontable / contable nouns?

How much for uncountable nouns?

How many cars do you have?

Demostrative adjectives, affirmative, negative and question forms

Regularly adjectives Demonstratives are found in the singular and plural: this pen - these pen; that notebook - those notebooks.

Example

That house over there is mine

Each of these demonstrative adjectives can have the following grammatical form.

That is used for singular nouns that you have far

These is used for plural nouns that you have close

Those is used for plural nouns that you have far

ONE and ONES as a demonstrative pronoun

are pronouns because they go instead of the noun either in singular and plural, this noun has to have been mentioned before, to know what refers

Examples

These ones are mine
Those ones are yours
