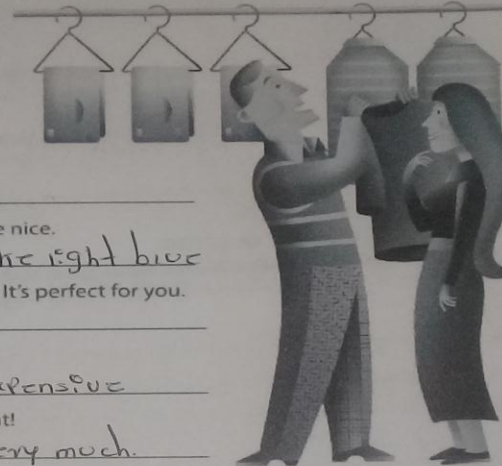

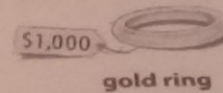
4. A: Hey, look at this silver ring! It's nice.
