Affirmative

negative

I am – i'm

I am not – i'm not

You are- you're

You are not __ you're not you aren't

He is- he's

he is not-__he's not he isn't

She is- she's

she is not__she's not she isn't

It is- it's

it is not__it's not it isn't

We are - we're

we are not__we're not we aren't

You are- you're

you are not-__you're not you aren't

They are- they're

they are not__they're not they aren't.

Interrogative

Am i not?__ Aren't i?

Are you not ?__aren't you?

Is he not?__isn't he?

Is she not?__isn't she?

Is it not?__isn't it?

Are we not?__aren't we?

Are you not?__aren't you?

Are they not?__aren't they?

Negative

We are not at home __we're not at home __we aren't at home

Interrogative

Are we at home?__aren't at home.
