You are-you're You are not \_\_you're not you aren't

He is- he's he is not-\_he's not he isn't

She is- she's she is not\_she's not she isn't

It is-it's it is not\_it's not it isn't

We are - we're we are not we aren't

You are- you're you are not-\_\_you're not you aren't

They are- they're they are not \_\_they aren't.

# Interrogative

Am i not?\_\_ Aren't i?

Are you not?\_\_aren't you?

Is he not?\_\_isn't he?

Is she not?\_\_isn't she?

Is it not?\_\_\_isn't it?

Are we not?\_\_aren't we?

Are you not?\_\_aren't you?

Are they not?\_\_aren't they?

## Ejemplo:

#### **Affirmative**

We are at home\_\_\_\_we're at home

#### **Negative**

We are not at home \_\_\_we're not at home \_\_we aren't at home

#### Interrrogative

Are we at home?\_\_aren't at home.
