Formas del presente simple en inglés

Affirmative form / Forma Afirmativa

Las oraciones del presente simple formadas de este modo se caracterizan por la sencillez de su estructura:

Subject + Verb + Complement

I play with my cousin.

(Yo juego con mi primo.)

Por ejemplo:

- ***José drinks coffee.***
José bebe café.

- ***We practice our English lessons.***

Nosotros practicamos nuestras lecciones de inglés.

El verbo principal se configura según las normas que aprendiste anteriormente, agregando o no la **"-s"** al final.

SI EL SUJETO DE LA ORACIÓN ES :

HE, SHE, IT = SI SE LE AGREGA "S" AL VERBO, EJEMPLO: MARIA EATS CEREAL.

EN CUANTO A LAS PREGUNTAS CERRADAS (PREGUNTAS QUE SOLO NECESITAN RESPUESTAS DE YES O NO)

EMPIEZAN CON DO = SI LOS SUJETOS SON YOU, WE , THEY, I. EJEMPLO: DO THE STUDENTS GO TO SCHOOL?

EMPIEZAN CON DOES SI LOS SUJETOS SON HE, SHE, IT. EJEMPLO: DOES YOUR TEACHER WORK ON SUNDAYS?

***** NOTA IMPORTANTE:

- EN LAS PREGUNTAS, AUNQUE LOS SUJETOS SEAN HE, SHE, IT, YA NO SE LE PONE UNA "S" AL VERBO. EJEMPLO:
- DOES MARIA EAT CEREAL?

Negative form / Forma negativa

Para formar oraciones negativas en inglés, es necesario que utilicemos la ayuda del verbo auxiliar **do** y del auxiliar negativo **not**.

El verbo **do** cambia de forma según el sujeto (o pronombre) con el que se conjuga, así:

I	_____	Do not
He / She /It	_____	Does not
You / We / They	_____	Do not

Entonces, a la hora de realizar una oración, basta con seguir esta fórmula:

Subject + Auxiliary Verb + Not + Principal Verb + Complement

I do not play with my cousin.

(Yo no juego con mi primo.)

Interrogative form / Forma interrogativa

Para las oraciones que se formulan de esta manera, también será necesario utilizar el verbo auxiliar **do**, pero ubicado al inicio de la oración:

Auxiliary Verb + Subject + Principal Verb + Complement ?

Do you play with your cousin?

(¿Tú juegas con tu primo?)

Por ejemplo:

- ***Does José drinks coffee?***
¿José bebe café?
- ***Do we practice our english lessons?***
¿Nosotros practicamos nuestras lecciones de ingles
