Negative Negativo	Subject + To be + Not + Verb + Ing + Complement
Interrogative Interrogativo	To be + Subject + Verb + Ing + Complement?

Present Continuos		
Afirmativo	Negativo	Interrogativo
I'm running	They are not waiting for you.	Are they waiting for you? - No, they are not
You are talking to Ana	It is not raining	Is it raining? - Yes, it is
He's cooking right now	He is not sleeping	Is he sleeping? - No he is not sleeping
She is playing the piano	She is not cleaning the room now	Is she cleaning the room now? - Yes, she is cleaning the room now
It's rinring	He is not taking a bath	Is she looking for the book? - No, she is not
We are studing	I'm not fixing the machine	Is he taking a bath? - Yes, he is taking a bath
You're playing football	We are not planning a party	Am I fixing the machine? - Yes, I am
They are riding a horse	They are not studying	Are we planning a party? - No, we are not planning a party
He is playing	We are not playing soccer	Are they studying? - Yes, they are
It is raining	She is not looking for the book	Are we playing soccer? - No, we are no playing soccer
