He can not run very fast

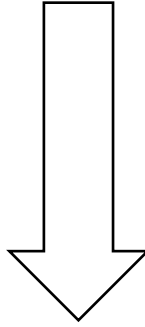

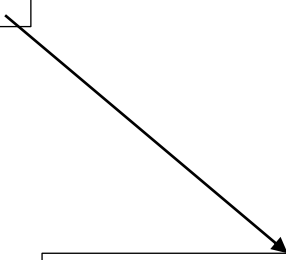
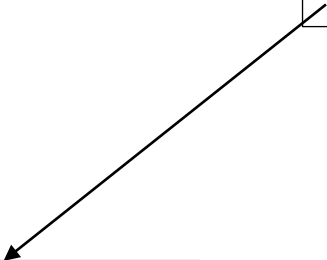
It is used with all pronouns in English and unlike other verbs, it remains the same for the third person singular, and for the plural forms.
