Possessive adjectives are those that modify the noun by adding an idea of belonging or possession.

The possessives correspond to the three grammatical persons. In both genres and numbers. Possessive adjectives coincide in number and gender with the name of the thing owned and not with the owner or possessor. When the adjectives mine, mine; yours, yours, yours his and its plurals are prepended to the name suffer apocope, which means that they lose one or more letters of the ending.

Those of the 1st person lose the vowels a, o and those of the 2nd and third. The syllables I, now: my husband, your children, his fortune, if they put postponed it would say: my husband, your children his fortune. The words mine, yours, his. When without preceded by the articles the or the are pronouns and not adjectives. My cat is prettier than yours.

List of possessive adjectives of a single possessor:

First person:

my, my, my, my

Second person:

you, his, yours, your, his, yours, his

Third person:

his, his,

List of possessive adjectives of various possessors:

First person:

our, our, our, our

Second person:

his, yours, yours, his, yours, yours

Third person:

his, his

Only the word our, acquires the gender of the noun that it modifies, and in the plurals ours and ours, just as in the case of your, yours, your yours.

Another type of possessive adjective is the accented possessive. It is formed like the possessive pronoun but, unlike this, it loses the article when it becomes an adjective. Furthermore, it also differs from simple possessive adjectives, which are placed before the noun they modify; This accented possessive adjective is placed after the noun it modifies.
