Adjetive possessive

Possessive determiners are a subclass of determiners that modify a noun by attributing possession to someone or something. They are also known as possessive adjectives, although the latter term is sometimes used with a broader meaning.

- ✤ You have a color. It is your color.
- ✤ She has a pet. It is her pet.
- ✤ Paul has a phone. It is her phone.
- ✤ I have a pencil. Is my pencil.
- ✤ He has a TV. It is his TV.
- **Mike has a car. <math>It is her car.**
- ✤ She has a mirror, It is her mirror.
- ✤ You have a brown bike. It is your brown bike.
- ✤ He has a big bottle. It is his big botter.
- ✤ She have a little cat. It is her little cat.
