

Adjective possessive

Possessive determiners are a subclass of determiners that modify a noun by attributing possession to someone or something. They are also known as possessive adjectives, although the latter term is sometimes used with a broader meaning.

- ❖ You have a color. It is your color.
- ❖ She has a pet. It is her pet.
- ❖ Paul has a phone. It is her phone.
- ❖ I have a pencil. It is my pencil.
- ❖ He has a TV. It is his TV.
- ❖ Mike has a car. It is her car.
- ❖ She has a mirror. It is her mirror.
- ❖ You have a brown bike. It is your brown bike.
- ❖ He has a big bottle. It is his big bottle.
- ❖ She has a little cat. It is her little cat.
