It **is** ➤ (+) The butterfly is flying(-) The butterfly is not flaying (¿?) Is the butterfly flyiing?

You **are** ➤ (+) You are buying a red car (-) You are not buying a red car (¿?) Are you buying a red car?

They **are** ➤ (+) They are running on the Street (-) They are not running on the street (¿?) Are they runnin on the street'

We **are** ➤ (+) We are watching T.V (-) We are not watching T.V (¿?) Are we watching T.V?

## Affirmative

1. Molly is the Singer in the band
2. The sun is coming
3. Alicia is playing with her sister
4. The cat is drinking milk
5. Pablo is cleaning the kitchen

## Negative

1. Molly is not a Singer in the band
2. The sun is not coming
3. Alicia it is not playing with her sister
4. The cat it is not drinking milk
5. Pablo is not cleaning the kitchen

## Interrogative

1. Is molly the Singer in the band? Yes, she is
2. Is the sun coming? Yes, it is.
3. Is Alicia playin with her sister? Yes, Alicia is

4. Is the cat drinking milk? Yes, the cat is.
5. Is pablo cleaning the kitchen? Yes, Pablo is.
