possessive pronouns

the pronoun plays the role of a possessive adjective and is always written before the noun that is qualifying in the sentence. They indicate possession or belonging, each corresponding to a person or grammatical subject.

The possessive pronouns in English are: mine, yours, his, hers, ours, yours, theirs. They indicate possession and are invariable. They are never preceded by an article.

EXAMPLES

1. I have a key. You don't have yours.
2. Those trousers are yours
3. Who does this book belong to? It's his.
4. I study english with a friend of hers.
5. Those trousers are ours
6. don't eat that sandwich, it's mine.
7. Your hair is prettier than hers.
8. The cat is his
