

Demonstrative pronouns

WHAT ARE THEY?

Demonstrative pronouns are words that are used to allude to a subject without having to mention it. These pronouns allow to indicate distance or closeness with respect to the emitter.

EXAMPLES

THIS

1. This book is mine
2. This is my Math book

THAT

1. That exercise is easy
2. That is my Math book

THESE

1. These chairs are very comfortable
2. These motorbikes are expensive

THOSE

1. Those exercises are easy
2. Those cars are dirty
