Superiority comparisons as the name implies compare things. The features that allow comparison are called adjectives and in the majority "er" is added to form the comparison. Example: My brother's apartment is smaller.

Other adjectives are long-longer, short-shorter, old-older, low-lower.

If the adjective ends in "e" an "r" is added. Example this salesman is nice but the first one was nicer. Late-later, rare-rarer.

Adjectives ending in consonant duplicate the final consonant for example sadsadder, wet-wetter, fat-fatter.

When the adjective ends in "y" it is changed to an "i" and added to the end "er". For example sunny-sunnier, funny-funnier, dirty-dirtier. In these it is possible to use "more" to form the comparison.

In some cases it does not have a specific shape for the comparison and you should use "more" to form them, they are usually adjectives that have more than two syllabs for example more beautiful, more careful, more boring.
