- Adjectives don't. have a plural form. a **green hat**; ~~two green~~ **two green hats**.

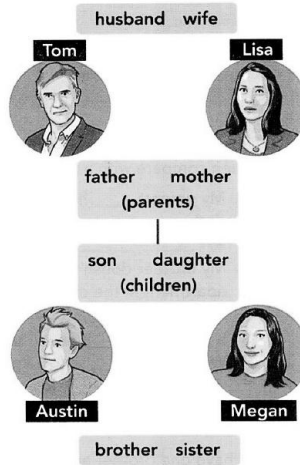

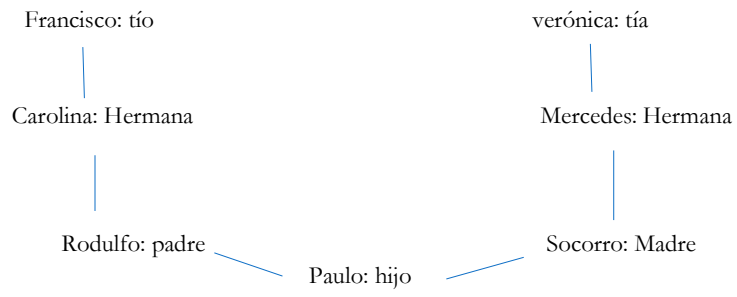
