Possessive pronouns

In addition to this, and as its name indicates, possessive pronouns differ from traditional ones because they indicate belonging. In short, they replace the noun and indicate membership at the same time.

I: Mine this bag is mine

He: His this pencil is his

She: Hers those keys are hers

It: Its this toy belongs to the dog

We: Ours this food is ours

You: Yours the computer is yours

They: Theirs the notebooks are theirs
