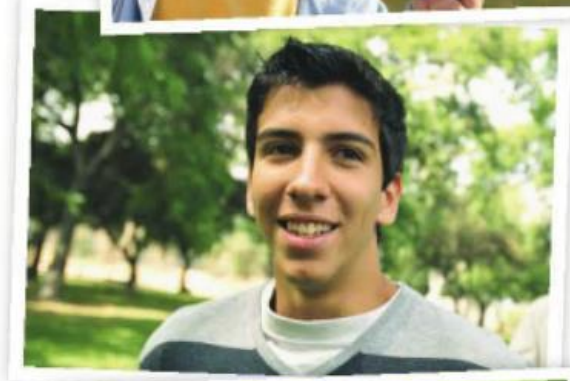

- ▶ In answers about age, you can use only the number or the number + *years old*: He's **18**. OR He's **18 years old**.
