- + Martha speaks four languages

Sentences with no third persons.

- + I watch TV sometimes.
- + I speak when Im aslepp.
- + I listens to the radio every day.
- + I watches TV with family after work.
- + My cat plays with my toys all day long.

Sentences with does not

- + She does not read the newspaper every day.
- + He does not watch his son in the park
- + The dog does not chase the cat all around the house.
- + He does not like to sit in the sun.
- + He does not study for his english class.

Sentences with do not

- + We do not come to school by bus.
- + You do not work very hard.
- + We do not eat together every day.
