✚ Affirmative sentences with third persons.

- 1.He studies every day at home.
- 2.She goes to her aunt every week.
- 3.It a colourfull garden.
4. They always sleep together.
5. He plays ball on Sundays.

✚ Sentences with no third persons.

- 1.I start work every day at 8 am.
2. You speak English very well.
3. I watches TV with family after work.
4. you make the pictures.
5. I study the instructions every time I buy a washing.

✚ Sentences with does not

1. He does not study for his English class.
2. She does not attend church every day.
3. It does not work.
4. He does not watch his son in the park.
5. She does not like to sit in the sun.

✚ Sentences with do not

1. I do not work.
2. We do not come to school by bus.
3. You do not work very hard.
4. We do not play in the park every day.
5. They do not play tennis on Sundays.

✚ Sentences with interrogative auxiliary do

- 1.Do we come to school by bus? Yes, we do.
- 2.Do they always play tennis on Sundays? Yes, they do.
- 3.Do you speak several foreign languages? No, you don't.
- 4.Do we go to the movies every weekend? No, we don't.
5. Do we play in the park every day? Yes, we do.

✚ Sentences with interrogative auxiliary does

- 1.Does she read the newspaper every day? Yes, she does.
- 2.Does he watch his son in the park? No, he doesn't.
- 3.Does she eat in the cafeteria every day? Yes, she does.
