A corner is "a point where two converging lines meet, forming an angle, either external or internal."



EXAMPLES

- Where is the cake shop? It is on the corner of Eighth Street and Sixth Street.
- Where is the college? It is on the corner of Julio Cortes and Hidalgo.
- Where is the drug store? It is on the corner of boulevard "5 de mayo" with the federal highway.
- Where is the bakery? It is on the corner of Constitución street and the water purifying.
- Where is the clinic? It is on the corner of school secondary and the auditorium.

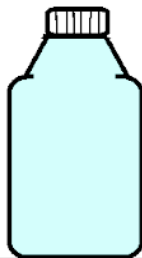
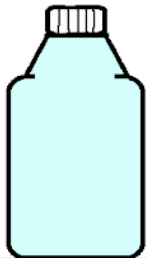

- Where is university? It is between the college boulevard and highway.
- Where is the veterinary? It is between the state primary and the hardware store.
- Where is the technology square? It is between the mall and Kabah Street.
- Where is the beach? It is between the hotel "Mirador" and port "Progreso".
- Where is the mall? It is between the Sport center and the Oxxo.



Prepositions of place

You use next to before a negative, or a word that suggests something negative, to mean almost, but not completely.

EXAMPLES

- Where is the library? It is next to my house.
- Where is the store? It is next to tortillería.
- Where is the restaurant? It is next to the taquería.
- Where is the museum? It is next to the Square Cristal.
- Where is the sport center? It is next to flower shop.

- Where is the ball? It is across from the soccer field.
- Where is my cousin? She is across from the park.
