## INTRODUCTION

In questions, the auxiliary do or does always goes at the beginning of the sentence, before the subject. Remember: does is used for he, she and it.

The same thing happens with questions as with negations: with he, she and it the main verb does not carry s, and has becomes have; for example: Does she take ...?, Does he have ..?, etc.

To form the interrogative we have to invert the auxiliary and the subject, that is, we invert the auxiliary 'do' and the subject. Do they work in an office? Do they work in an office? We do the same in the third person, but in this case we invert the auxiliary 'does'.
