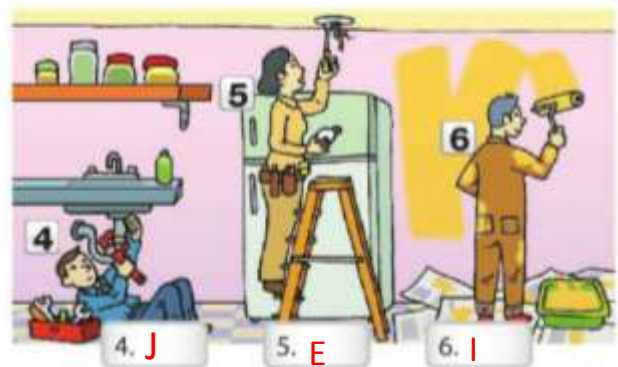

**WHO, WHOSE, WHAT, WHICH, WHERE, WHEN, WHY, HOW**
