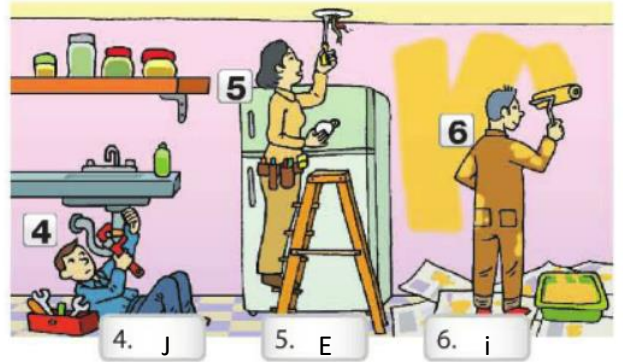

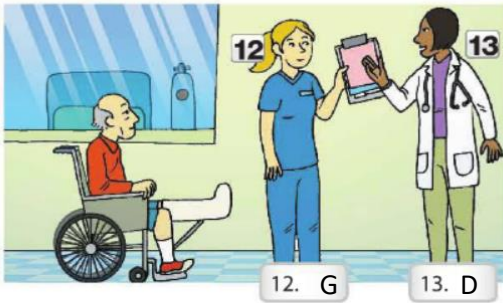
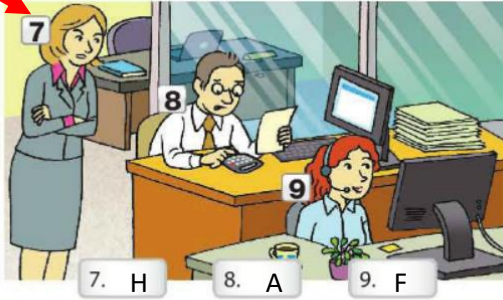

(PREGUNTAS CON WHERE, WHAT, HOW)

Las **WH-Question Words** son partículas interrogativas que utilizamos para hacer preguntas en inglés. Suelen causar mucha confusión a principiantes ya que se escriben de manera muy similar [empiezan por wh- (. *who*, *where*) o contienen wh (HoW)]. Éstas son:

**WHO, WHOSE, WHAT, WHICH, WHERE, WHEN, WHY, HOW**
